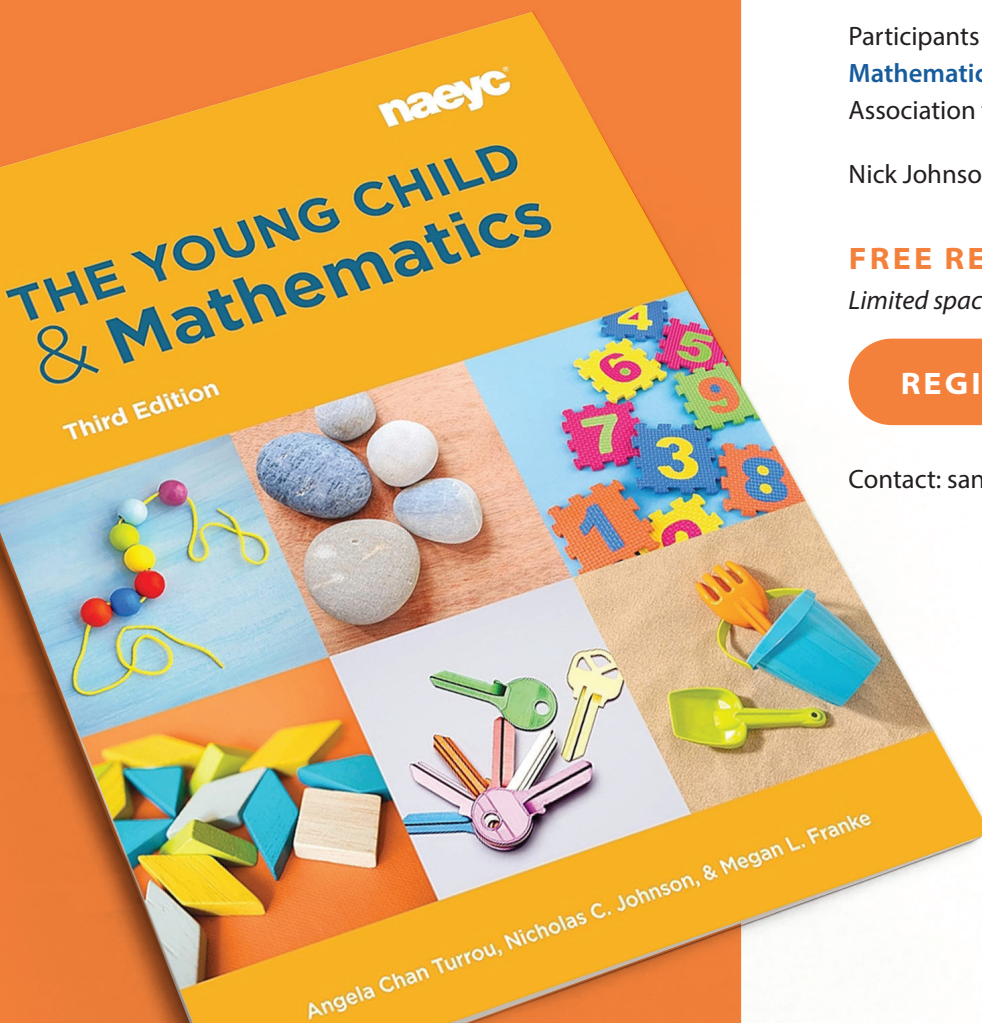


# Young Children's Mathematics
